7 The Ancestors of WILLIAM M. FALES

His father was Seth Ellis⁶ FALES,
born October 15, 1811 in New London, New Hampshire, (SHEPHERD?)
married Julia Ann TUSKER. She was born in Maine in
1815 and died February 25, 1883 in Williamsburg, Brooklyn.
He died June 7, 1868 at 187 Grand Street, Williamsburg.

His father was Samuel⁵ FALES,
born May 2, 1786 in New London, New Hampshire. ELLIS!
His wife Susannah died February 10, 1862 in New London.
He died December 25, 1861 in New London.

His father was Nathaniel⁴ FALES,
born January 20, 1760 in Dedham, Massachusetts,
served in the Continental Army in 1778,
married Mary EVERETT of Dedham on February 17, 1780.
She died in New London in March, 1829. ERROR:
He died in New London on January 11, 1835. 16 MAY 1829
(TOMBSTONE)

His father was David³ FALES,
born in 1702 in Dedham Massachusetts.
His second wife, Mary DAMON was the mother of Nathaniel⁴.
They both died in 1793 and are buried in Dedham.

His father was James² FALES,
born July 4, 1656 in Dedham, Massachusetts,
married Deborah FISCHER. ERROR: FISHER
He (or his father) fought against the Indians in King
Philip's War, 1676.

His father was James¹ FALES,
born in England, approximately 1615,
was in Dedham Massachusetts in 1651,
married Ann BROCK in Dedham on July 28, 1655. — ERROR: 28 MAY 16
He died on July 10, 1708.

Her father was Henry BROCK,
born in England; his wife was named Elizabeth
He was in Dedham, Massachusetts in 1642,
died in Dedham in 1652.

The family of William M.⁷ FALES

William M.⁷ FALES was born August 21, 1851 in Williamsburg, Brooklyn, probably at 76 Grand Street where his father, Seth Ellis⁶ FALES made and sold umbrellas and where the family also lived. He followed various occupations during his life including umbrella maker, furniture maker, teamster, carpenter and laborer. In 1871 he married Anna FLYNN. She was born December 5, 1852 in New York, the daughter of Irish immigrants. Her father's name was ~~William~~ but her mother's name is not known.

William M.⁷ FALES died July 28, 1923 in Sea View Hospital on Staten Island. Anna (FLYNN) FALES died April 19, 1922 at 204 Stagg Street in the Williamsburg section. Together with their son, Charles, they are buried in Plot #5493, Mt. Olivet Cemetery, Maspeth, New York.

Their children were:

Adelaide⁸, born May 13, 1872. According to the 1900 U.S. census, she had been married for five years at that time. However, no marriage name was shown and she was living with her parents at that time. The date and place of her death are not known.

Edward⁸, born in 1874. He had two children, Seth⁹ and Raymond⁹. Seth was born about 1902 and was in the Merchant Marine.

William M.⁸, born in 1876, married Margaret DORSEY. They had 12 children. More details on this large family will follow in a future Bulletin. A number of their children and grandchildren (and great grandchildren) live in the New York-Long Island area and in Florida.

George Albert⁸, born November 7, 1878, married Catherine DWYER. They had two children, George⁹ and Catherine⁹. George⁹ is married to May ZWICK. They live in Elmont, Long Island. More details on this family will follow in the next Bulletin.

Joseph⁸, born in 1880. He married and had one daughter. He was an early believer in the health value of natural foods. In later years, he lived in the home of his brother, Frank at 65 Guernsey Street in the Greenpoint section of Brooklyn where he died in the mid-1930's. On Guernsey St. and in nearby McCarren Park, he was called "The Candy Man", because the children always knew he could be counted on for a piece of candy from the supply he kept in his pockets.

Charles⁸, born February 18, 1890. He fought in World War I and was seriously wounded and gassed. He died on July 14, 1922 in St Anthony's Hospital, Richmond Hill.

All the children of William M. and Anna FALES were born in Brooklyn with the exception of George Albert who was born in Vermont, possibly in Brattleboro.

The Family of Frank⁸ FALES

Frank⁸ FALES, who was christened Francis Aloysius, was born May 3, 1883 in Williamsburg, Brooklyn, the son of William M. and Anna (FLYNN) FALES. In his early years he drove a team of horses, but later when his vision became seriously impaired he worked as a laborer.

In 1912 on May 3 in Brooklyn he married Mary RATHJEN. "Mamie", as she was generally called, was the daughter of Jakob RATHJEN, a German immigrant, and Fanny O'KEEFE, the daughter of Irish immigrants. Frank and Mary FALES had four children:

Frank⁹ (Francis Andrew), born April 24, 1914 on Keap Street in Williamsburg, married Ann Thomasina MARMER of Bryn Mawr, Pennsylvania in 1945. They have one son, Kevin Gerard¹⁰ born March 12, 1950 married Betty-Jean PRICOLA of Maspeth in St. Mary, Help of Christians Church on July 15, 1972. Kevin and Betty-Jean live in Douglaston, New York and have a daughter, Pamela¹¹, born ~~July~~ 12, 1981.

Frank⁸ FALES died May 30, 1968, Mary (RATHJEN) FALES died Dec. 26, 1976, both at the Elmhurst City Hospital. They are buried in Plot 2, Grave 6179, Mt. Olivet Cemetery, Maspeth, with Anna RATHJEN.
